



2021 Picture Weeks Guide

General Information

- This year we'll be having **picture weeks from April 18-30** during regular classes instead of our traditional picture day.
- Every dancer will get professional pictures taken in their costume with their hair & make up done during their regular class times during these weeks.
- We will only be taking individual pictures this year. No group photos will be taken due to social distancing. Anything the dancers touch will be sanitized in between each person.
- You'll be able to come in to the studio to view your proofs and order your pictures approximately 1-2 weeks after pictures are taken.

When does my dancer get their picture taken?

- Every dancer who is in class in the studio from April 18-22 will get their pictures taken from April 18-22, 2021.
- Dancers who ARE NOT in the studio from April 18-22 will get their pictures taken from April 25-29, 2021.

Costume, Hair & Makeup Information

All costume, hair & make up information is available on the [show hub on our website](#) for each class. Please refer to this document for how to do your dancers hair & makeup.

Dancers will need to arrive to their picture week class with their hair and makeup complete. When they arrive they should be wearing their normal dress code that they wear to class each week (ex: tights, bodysuit, shoes, etc.)

Dancers will be given their costume to change into when they arrive at the studio. After taking their pictures they will change back into their normal dance wear. We will then package their costume up in a garment bag and they will take it home so they have it for recital. After recital you'll drop the costume off at the studio or leave it with us on recital day as it is property of TDC.

Ordering

Approximately 1-2 weeks after pictures are taken you'll be able to come in to the studio to view your proofs and order your pictures. There are a variety of different package options, including digital pictures and prints, at a variety of price points.

All orders must be made by May 17, 2021.
